Tiebreakers

No overtime. Pool play games that are tied at the end of regulation time will remain tied. If there is a tie at the end of a championship, the game will go an extra two 5-minute overtime periods followed by penalty kicks if there is still a tie (per AHSAA rules).

Pool Play Tiebreakers (in order)

Head to head competition Highest goal differential (Max of 4 goal differential per match) Fewest goals against Penalty kicks

The first team listed will be the home team and should wear dark. The home team should also provide 3 match balls.

We are also asking that each team provide one ball runner for each match.

Gates will open one hour prior to the first scheduled match on each day.

This is an AHSAA sanctioned event, and all yellow cards and red cards will be reported to the AHSAA.
